Diabetes Mellitus 2

Young Newly diagnosed tight HBA1c control <53

Older and Long Term DM2 58-64 Tighter if complications e.g. eye changes

International Diabetes Federation Guideline 2013

SIGN Guideline better than NICE Guideline

SU potentiated by Macrolide [Erythromycin]

PGZ risk slight Bladder Cancer risk Not if HF

DPP4s Expensive Modest Effect Not if HF or Pancreatitis

SGLT2 Expensive Increased UTIs and Thrush Not with Furosemide

GPL1s Expensive Nausea a problem Possibility of Pancreatitis and Pancreatic cancer
